VIII. COMMITTEE UPDATES:

a. Enrollment Strategies – Key Message:

We are still down about 168 FTES for this academic year. Pam Deegan has been engaged to do a thorough analysis of our fill rates, WSCH/FTEF, Fall-Spring trends, etc. She'll look by division and by department and then drill down. Nath/Tarman still working on the Data Warehouse with update anticipate or April. Committee is discussing how to improve use of waitlists by both students and department chairs/deans so that we can get those students into the classes they need; gathering information about needed data, accuracy and availability of Reports for chairs and coordinators; Goal: get to 80% fill rate for all sections. Hoping to eventually give department chairs/deans FTES targets, along with all the tools and data needed to make innovations in the schedule.

b. Faculty Staffing – Key Message:

The Faculty Staffing Committee will be meeting on March 30th to discuss timelines and the scoring rubric. Please send any comments, concerns and/or ideas that you would like to have the committee review to your divisional representative.

c. Classified Staffing – Key Message:

The Classified Staffing Committee will be meeting early April to begin the staffing process for 2015/16

d. Facilities Report – Key Message:
