3. Achieve a score of 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement Exam in a language other than English.				
4. Achieve a score of 500-540 (depending on the language-verify with counselor) on the SAT II: Subject Test in Languages other than English				
 Achieve a score of 5 or higher on the International Baccalaureate (IB) Examinations in a language other than English. English "O" level exams (score of "A," "B" or "C") and English International "A" exams (score of 5, 6 or 7) also accepted. 				
6. Documented satisfactory completion of 2 or more years of formal schooling at the 6th grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is not English. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher.

Courses may be taken with a "P" (Pass) but both the CSU and UC systems have a limit on the number of units.

Students must request official certification of IGETC in Admissions and Records/Evaluations.
