- Must be pursuing a Certificate or A.A. in Dance at Grossmont College
- Must have either participated in the Fall 2019 "Breaking Boundaries" dance concert or will be participating as a dancer in the Spring 2020 "Entrances & Exits" dance concert
- Must be a positive role model and demonstrate leadership in the classroom
