Teachers Quit in Retreat Beer Row. Four Grossmont College instructors who permitted students to drink beer and wine at an academic retreat have resigned. Harold G. Hughes, president of the two-year college at El Cajon, Calif., said Tuesday that George H. Peranteau, Hugh W. Peterson Jr., Harold J. Loumeau and Andrew W. Neber resigned when faced with the prospect of dismissal by the trustees. Hughes said the teachers used poor judgment in allowing the students to drink but added that there was no evidence of drunkenness or disorderly conduct. Seven students under 21 who attended the retreat last month have been suspended but will be allowed to continue in school.
