3 Teachers, Administrator Hired for DuPage College

DuPage County Appointments of three new faculty members for College of DuPage were approved by the college board Thursday. In addition, one appointment to the administrative staff was approved.

Total appointments now are 65 faculty members and 11 administrative staffers.

The administrative appointee is John H. Anthony, associate dean of arts, effective July 1.

Anthony has been associated with Peirce Junior College in Philadelphia since 1961 and his most recent position with Peirce was as dean of instruction.

He received his Ed. D in bus-

ness education (to be conferred this fall) from Temple University in Philadelphia.

James L. Heinselman has been appointed physics teacher effective Sept. 5.

He has been chairman of the physical sciences and mathematics department at Port Huron Junior College in Port Huron, Mich., since 1960.

In addition to his M.A. degree, he also has successfully completed 35 graduate semester hours in physics.

OLEH M. KURITZA, who has been associated with the Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago since 1962, has been ap-

pointed electrical - electronic technology teacher.

Prior to his affiliation with IIT, Kuritza was project engineer for Motorola in Chicago. His appointment will become effective Sept. 5.

George H. Peranteau has been appointed English teacher effective Sept. 5.

He has taught English at Grossmont College in El Cajon, Calif., since 1965.

In addition to his M.A. degree, he also has successfully completed 35 graduate semester hours in English at the University of California and the University of Chicago.
