## English Writing Center opens

The new EnglishWriting Center is now open in Room 550, for use by both students enrolled in English classes and those who are not.

"Anyone can sign up for the Center (English 299), for .5 units-3 units of credit," said English faculty member Sandia Tuttle.Services include personalized English instruction, tutoring, and the use of twenty-two Power Mac PCs with Internet access for typing papers.

Supervised Tutoring is available during Open Hours, with three student tutors to help with limited assistance in grammar and composition. Also during this time, students can do school-related research on the Internet and type their papers.

"The Macs will read and translate IBM disks, so work done elsewhere can be brought in and competed here," said Tuttle. Disks are also available at the Center for purchase.

The Extended Writing Studies hours allow students to come in for personalized instruction with an English faculty member, either Albert Moorin or Tuttle.

The class is not graded, and all interested students are encouraged to attend.
