




Corey Ransom, 1998

The Bakersfield Shrine Potato Bowl game, sponsored by the Shriners, was the largest JC football Bowl game in the country averaging 12,000 fans a game. Grossmont was privileged to play in the game both in 1998 and 2000. In '98 **Corey Ransom** (Helix HS) ran for over 1,200 yards during the season. He gained a total of 185 yards against Bakersfield in the '98 Potato Bowl game for the win and was named MVP. He scholarrhipped to Washington State but left early. **Dwayne Neabors** (Patrick Henry HS) was injured 3 games in 2000 but still managed to average 6.1 per carry and became the Offensive Player of the Game in the Bakersfield Potato Bowl of 2000 when he ran for 102 yards. He earned a scholarship to West Texas A&M.




Robert Hamilton, 1992

Robert Hamilton in 1992 ran for 1,192 yards for the Griffs, accepted an offer from Utah, and in one of Utah's biggest years became their star running back. **Conan Smith** had a 7.5 yds per carry and 1252 yds. He was offered a DI scholarship but came up short on his AA degree. However, he had two great years at NM Highlands (DII) and was named as one of the top 3 DII backs in the U.S. his senior year. He is a Lincoln HS grad. He had a 7.2 yards per carry in 1994 for the Griffs.




