In consideration of this contract the parties agree to the following:

1. It is understood that the ARTIST(S) agrees to perform and discharge all obligations as an independent contractor under any and all laws, existing or in the future, in anyway related to the engagement herein described, including, but not limited to, Social Security laws, contributions, unemployment responsibilities, public liability, and any union welfare payments under said laws.
2. The ARTIST(S) guarantees that in performing their act under the terms of this contract that they are not infringing on the property right, copyright, patent right, or any other rights of anyone else.
3. The leader of the ARTIST(S) shall be responsible for the conduct of the performing group.
4. The ARTIST(S) shall setup and ready to perform before _____.
5. All original contracted musicians shall appear at the agreed time. Any substitutions must be agreed upon twenty-four (24) hours prior to the performance by WACC.

6. (a) There will be a decibel meter at all performances. Performances cannot exceed a maximum decibel level of ninety-five (95) sustained, one hundred and fifteen (115) decibel bursts for a maximum of 10 seconds not exceed three (3) bursts.

After one warning, if the ARTIST(S) is still in violation of the said limits, any Administrator of Grossmont College has the option to terminate the performance, the contract will be considered null and void with no payment to the ARTIST(S) to be made.

- (b) No guests, except by written prior engagement with WACC shall be brought to the event.
- (c) No members of the PERFORMING GROUP shall be under the influence of either alcoholic beverages, illegal substances during the performance, bring such beverages or substances on the college campus, openly endorse on the campus the used of such substances.
- (d) The ARTIST(S) shall adhere to the wishes of WACC as to the selection played, including but not limited to, the nature of lyrics, verbal and/or non-verbal vulgarity and/or indecency. After one warning, if the ARTIST(S) still ignores WACC's request, WACC has the option to terminate the performance, the contract will be considered null and void with no payment to the ARTIST(S).

7. ARTIST(S) will supply all required equipment (microphone, piano, sound system, etc.) unless otherwise stipulated here.

8. Any violation of the above may cause WACC to cancel this contract.
