Earthquake _____

- DROP to the ground (before the earthquake drops you!)

After Earthquake

• Prepare for aftershocks

Biohazard/Chemical

- Evacuate the immediate area
- Call Risk Management at extension 7710 or Facilities at extension 7594

Intruder or Violent Incident

While in a classroom or office:

- Make note of your location
- Call 9-911 or 911 (on your cell)

While on District property, outside of a building:

- Use emergency telephones in parking lots for assistance or
- Call 911 (from any phone) and follow instructions

When Calling

- 1. Always attempt calling campus number first.
- 2. Give your name.
- 3. Give your telephone number.
- 4. Give your location.
- 5. Describe the problem.
- 6. Don't hang up! Stay on the line.
