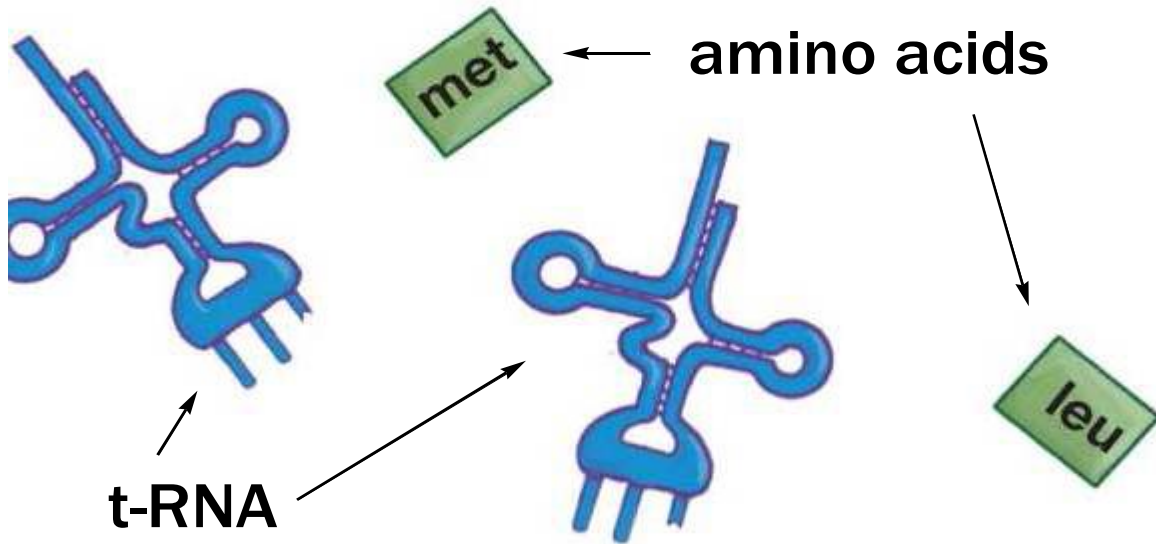
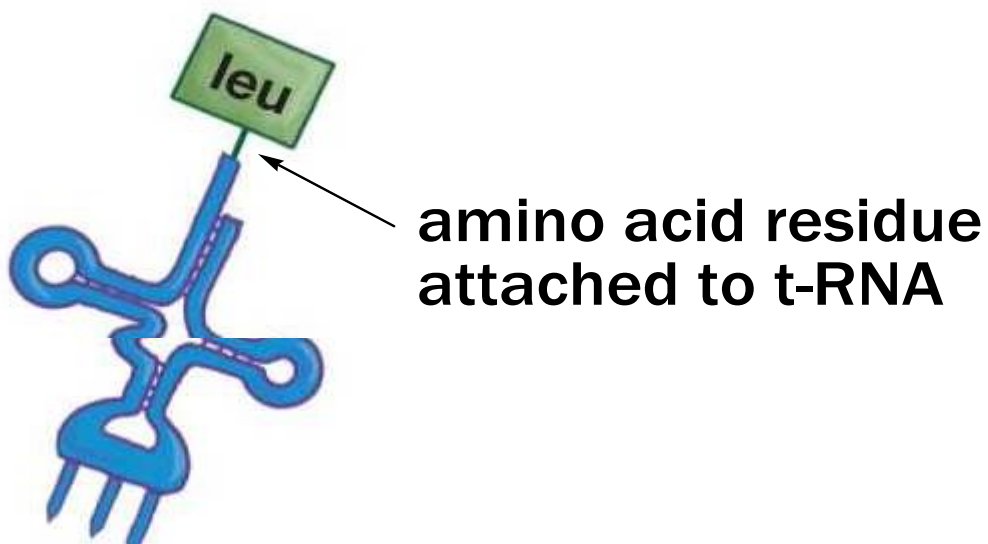


Amino acids and t-RNA located in the cytoplasm.



Specific enzymes recognize the anti-codon of t-RNA and attach the corresponding amino acid to the t-RNA.

The amino acid residue attached to t-RNA is then transported to the ribosome.



At the ribosome, the anti-codon of t-RNA links to corresponding codon of m-RNA.
