Biology-6 semester hours, 2 courses with labs:

BIO 120, 140, 141/142, 144, 145

<u>Chemistry – 12 semester hours</u>

General/Inorganic Chemistry – minimum of 3 semesters hours with a lab

CHEM 141, 142

Organic Chemistry-6 semester hours, 2 courses required with labs: CHEM 231, 232

Additional 3 required hours may be fulfilled with any of the above classes

Physics and related studies – 6 semesters

3 semester hours in Physics with a lab and 3 semester hours in Biomechanics, Kinesiology, Statistics, Exercise Physiology or an additional course in Physics

PHYSICS 110

Any course in Biomechanics, Kinesiology, Statistics or Exercise Physiology

English, Communications and/or Language Skills – 6 semester hours

Any 2 courses in the English department, Speech or Oral Communications

Psychology-3 semester hours

Any course in the psychology department

<u>Humanities/Social Sciences-15 semester hours</u>

Any combination of 15 hours from the following departments: Sociology, History, Anthropology, Speech, Psychology, Music Appreciation, Art Appreciation, Geography, English, Foreign Language, Humanities, Philosophy, Classical Studies, Mass Communication
