

## 2009-2010 Grossmont College Articulation Agreement: Lower Division Major Requirements for Bachelor of Science (Foreign MD Track)

Please note Community College students can transfer to InterAmerican College at any time as long as they have completed IAC minimum enrollment requirements. IAC's minimum requirement is a High School Diploma or equivalent.

## Specialized degree program for foreign students who have a foreign M.D. who want a Bachelor of Science degree.

The IAC experience: IAC students will have the opportunity to complete their Bachelor's and/or Master's degrees in an educationally enriching environment in courses that are held just two days a week in the evening. Each course is one month long or nine sessions in duration, making it easy for students to work and carry out life activities successfully and fully while in school. Information about the Bachelor of Science (Foreign MD track) degree program: 1) The Bachelor of Science (Foreign MD track) degree program is for students who have completed a Medical Degree in a foreign Country and would like to get a US Bachelor's Degree. 2) The foreign MD to BS degree consists of 14 courses. 3) Of the 42 units needed to complete this program, 12 units can be completed at a community college. IAC requires that students must complete a minimum of 30 units at IAC.

## Lower Division Major Requirements for Bachelor of Science (Foreign MD track) degree:

- 1) Students must complete all transfer classes with a "C" grade or above.
- 2) Students should not complete more than 12 units total from below prior to transfer & should see an Academic Counselor
- 3) Students interested in IAC post-baccalaureate programs in Health or Science need a science GPA of 2.5
