

## 2009-10 Grossmont College Articulation Agreement: Lower Division General Education Requirements

Please note Community College students can transfer to InterAmerican College at any time as long as they have completed IAC minimum enrollment/transfer requirements. IAC's minimum requirement is a High School Diploma or equivalent.

*Transfer Information: Students must have a High School diploma or GED or have passed the High School Equivalency exam. Transfer students can transfer up to 60 lower division units from Transfer Level Courses to IAC under the following conditions: 1) Students must have a GPA of 2.0 in all transfer courses, AND 2) Each transfer course must be completed with a "C" grade or better.  
\*Please note InterAmerican College does not accept "D" grades.*

*Liberal Studies majors: see Lower Division Major and GE Requirements for Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies form instead.*

<b>Area B: Science, Math and Technology</b> <i>(Please complete one course from each area to include one B1, one B2, one B3 &amp; one B4 course as well as complete one lab course with either your B1 or B2 class).</i>	
B1: Life Sciences (3 units)	<b>BIOL 120:</b> Principles of Biology
B2: Physical Science (3 Units)	<i>Complete any B1 course from CSU Breadth General Education or any 5A course from IGETC</i>
B3: Mathematics (3 Units)	<i>Complete any B4 course from CSU Breadth General Education or any Category 2 mathematics course from IGETC</i>
B4: Technology (3 Units)	<b>CSIS 101:</b> Computer & Information Literacy <b>AND</b> <b>BOT 117:</b> Essential PowerPoint
<b>Area C: Humanities</b> <i>(Please complete 6 units to include 3 units from the Arts and 3 units from the Humanities)</i>	
C1: Arts (3 Units)	<i>Complete any C1 course from CSU Breadth General Education or any 3A course from IGETC</i>
C2: Humanities (3 Units)	<b>PHIL 110:</b> A General Introduction to Philosophy
<b>Area D: History and Social Science</b> <i>(Please complete two courses from D1 and one course from D2).</i>	
D1: History (6 Units)	<b>HIST 108:</b> Early American History <b>AND</b> <b>HIST 109:</b> Modern American History
D2: Social Science (3 Units)	<b>PSY 120:</b> Introductory Psychology
<b>Area E: Cultural Studies</b> <i>(Must be completed at IAC)</i>	
<i>Foreign Language Requirement: Please note some IAC majors require two semesters of a foreign language. If you are a bilingual student, you may complete this requirement with upper division courses after transfer. This requirement can also be met through AP or CLEP completion.</i>
