

### **General Overview: Curriculum and Admission**

National University has agreed to waive the \$60 application fee and scholarship the last two courses in a bachelor's degree for California Community College students who meet the following criteria:

1. Good academic standing at the time of transfer in all transferable coursework (minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher at the time of admission; some majors may require a higher incoming cumulative GPA.);
2. Completed (minimum of) 30 transferable semester units at a California Community College or combination of California Community Colleges;
3. Last semester of enrollment was at a California Community College.

Such students will have the following rights:

1. Retain catalog rights at National University from the academic year of first enrollment at the community college for lower division preparation for the major as long as they are continuously enrolled at a California Community College.
2. Retain catalog rights for general education requirements at the time of admission to National University.

Continuous enrollment means that a student has been attending one or more than one California Community College without more than two consecutive semester's break (summers excluded).

The year for catalog rights will be determined by the year of enrollment in a community college when continuous enrollment began.
