## Articulation Agreement Between Grossmont College and

## **Palmer College of Chiropractic**

The purpose of this agreement is to enhance the transition of Associate degree graduates from *Grossmont College* into baccalaureate degree programs at Palmer College of Chiropractic. The following agreement shall establish the conditions under which students from *Grossmont College* shall progress to senior or upper division status. This agreement is without a specified termination date; however, either party may terminate the agreement at any time provided students then currently enrolled shall be allowed to complete their course of studies pursuant to the terms of the agreement in effect at the time of termination.

NOTE: Students wishing to participate under the terms and conditions of this agreement must complete an Associate degree program at *Grossmont College*.

## <u>I. Articulation conditions for all *Grossmont College* Associate Degree Graduates admitted to Palmer College of Chiropractic:</u>

- A. Palmer College of Chiropractic shall accept the required general education credits earned at *Grossmont College*, applying them toward the equivalent lower division, general education requirements at Palmer College of Chiropractic.
- B. Acceptance to Palmer College of Chiropractic will be contingent upon meeting all Palmer College of Chiropractic admissions requirements.
- C. *Grossmont College* courses not applied to Palmer College of Chiropractic general distribution, major or specialization will be accepted and applied as general elective credits.
- D. Admissions, financial aid, advisement, and registration services will be provided by Palmer College of Chiropractic to those students who express an interest.

Students must complete 90 semester credit hours or 135 quarter credit hours of undergraduate studies, including the following specific courses required by Palmer. **See Pre-Chiropractic Curriculum**.

Further, for admissions to Palmer College of Chiropractic each student must:

- 1. Apply one year in advance of intended starting date.
- 2. The minimum cumulative grade point average in the prerequisite courses and the required 90 semester hours for entrance to Palmer College of Chiropractic is 2.50 on a 4.00 grading scale. Preference will be given to students earning a 2.75 or better. The lowest grade a student may earn in any of the required prerequisite courses is a "C" (2.00).
  - Complete at least eight courses at Grossmont College
- 3. Satisfy all other requirements as prescribed in the Palmer College of Chiropractic catalog.
