How to Reset Your WebAdvisor Password

Please follow this procedure to reset your WebAdvisor password:

- 1. Go to the WebAdvisor homepage at <u>http://wa.gcccd.edu</u>.
- 2. Click on the "What's My Password?" link in the bottom right hand corner:



4. Fill in your last name AND your Social Security Number -OR- your Student ID Number:

5. The next screen will ask you to select your email address. This will be the email that your temporary password will be mailed to:

6. In a new window, go open your email inbox, and look for an email from 'donnotreply@gcccd.edu':

- 7. Now go back to WebAdvisor http://wa.gcccd.edu and log in using your username (first.last) and the temporary password from the email.

9. Enter your username, and the "old password" is going to be the one you just used- the temporary one from the email. Pick a new password containing a word and a number. The password you create must be 6-9 characters in length (including digits) and should have both letters and numbers. An example would be "Apple2". We recommend you write this new password down and keep it in a safe place. Also, it is a good idea to give yourself a hint for the password to help you remember next time.

After you click submit, it will log you in and take you to the Main Menu. From now on, use your new password to access your account.
